The Upper Trinity Regional Water District (UTRWD) has secured its Permit from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (404 Permit) for Lake Ralph Hall. With this permit in hand, the District is ready to move forward with procurement of the various design and construction contracts required to develop the project.

One such contract is the Roadway Relocation Progressive Design-Build Contract. The scope of this contract will include the design and construction of the relocations and improvements to roadways necessary to support the development of Lake Ralph Hall. The roadway relocations and improvements include:

- Relocation of SH 34
- Relocation of FM 1550
- Abandonment of FM 2990 and portions of FM 1550
- Fannin County road improvements / abandonments

UTRWD will host a briefing to update members of the construction, engineering and design-build industry on the Lake Ralph Hall Project in general and the Roadway Relocation Progressive-Design-Build contract specifically on the date, time and place listed above. Interested members of the construction, engineering and design-build industry are invited.
