Fast Facts

Located in Fannin County, the lake will benefit the local and regional economy



To be constructed, owned, operated and maintained by UTRWD



180,000 acre-feet of water can be stored in the lake (approximately 59 billion gallons)



Lake surface area is approximately 7,600 acres, or just under 12 square miles



A good site, with limited wetlands, a naturally deep channel, and no gas and oil wells



New temporary and permanent fossil park sites to support fossil-hunting



54 million gallons can be used daily (on average)*



Providing recreational opportunities, such as fishing, boating and nature watching



UTRWD holds rights and owns the water — reducing dependency on others



Total project size is approximately 16,000 acres, including environmental improvement areas



32 miles (approximately) of new 66 – 72 inch diameter pipeline to deliver water for treatment
